Saint Mary's University has established a limited number of bursaries open to African Canadian applicants.

**Bursary Criteria:**

- open to high school and mature African Canadian students
- element of financial need
- satisfy admission requirements
- must have been born in or completed high school in Nova Scotia
- enroll at Saint Mary's University as a full time student
- nominated to the Director of Admissions by a joint Committee of Saint Mary's University and an African Nova Scotian Community partner

**Value:** This Bursary is valued at \$1000 and available to students interested in pursuing an undergraduate degree at Saint Mary's University.

**Number of Bursaries:** Up to a total of four Saint Mary's University African Canadian bursaries are available to entering students in any given year. One of the bursaries may be awarded to a mature student.

**Duration of Bursary:** one year

**Nomination deadline:** March 15

**Note:** Students who are awarded a Saint Mary's University African Canadian Bursary will also qualify for an Entrance Scholarship provided they have achieved a scholarship average of 80% or above.

**Requirements:**

1. Completed Saint Mary's University African Canadian Bursary *Confidential Application Form*
2. Letter of recommendation from the high school principal or guidance counsellor.
3. Résumé, which should comment on such things as involvement in community service, participation in student government, athletic achievement, extra curricular activities and volunteer and /or paid work.
4. Completed application for admission.
5. Copy of parent(s) and/or guardian(s) most recent Income Tax "Notice of Assessment". Please Note: This is required only if you would like to be considered for bursaries and scholarships which include a component of financial need.
